

## Quick Discharge to RCFE – What is needed?

- Completed Physician's Report (LIC602A) Must be signed by the Physician
- Medication List
- Negative TB Test results (whether via Chest X-ray or Skin Scratch test)
- Ordered Durable Medical Equipment (DME) hospital bed, oxygen equipment, wheelchair, walker, etc.
- Arranged Transportation

## **RED FLAGS!!**

- Feeding Tubes
- Behavioral issues Medications may need to be reviewed
- No DPOA (Medical or Financial) or Conservator If Patient is unable to make their own decisions, sign their own paperwork, and write a check to the home, a DPOA/Conservator will need to be in place
- Wounds Stage 3 and 4 Must be on Hospice to qualify for RCFE
- Secured Placement Needed Patient MUST have a Dementia Diagnosis on their 602 in order to be placed into a secured Memory Care
