

# Care Placement

## Quick Discharge to RCFE – What is needed?

- Completed Physician's Report (LIC602A) – Must be signed by the Physician
- Medication List
- Negative TB Test results (whether via Chest X-ray or Skin Scratch test)
- Ordered Durable Medical Equipment (DME) – hospital bed, oxygen equipment, wheelchair, walker, etc.
- Arranged Transportation

### **RED FLAGS!!**

- **Feeding Tubes**
- **Behavioral issues - Medications may need to be reviewed**
- **No DPOA (Medical or Financial) or Conservator - If Patient is unable to make their own decisions, sign their own paperwork, and write a check to the home, a DPOA/Conservator will need to be in place**
- **Wounds - Stage 3 and 4 - Must be on Hospice to qualify for RCFE**
- **Secured Placement Needed - Patient MUST have a Dementia Diagnosis on their 602 in order to be placed into a secured Memory Care**
