Step-by-step guide to help you along the way



Tour: Once you've reviewed the information sent to you, we recommend promptly touring the facilities and making a selection



Reservation: Admission fee and agreement are required to begin move-in process. Rooms are available on a first come first serve basis



Assessment: An in person assessment will be made to evaluate the best level of care for your loved one and determine a monthly rate



Documents: Complete move-in packet and all necessary documentation. When you sign the agreement, you'll need to have copies of the DPOA, personal identification cards, and <u>health care directives</u>



Health information: Prior to moving in, you will need a <u>Physician's Report-602A</u> (including TB test results), Pre-Assessment, POLST form, med list and negative covid test



Agreement: Submit the necessary move-in documents, sign the admission contract and provide payment



Move In: We will periodically check in with you to ensure everything is going well and that you are satisfied with the level of care your loved one is recieving
